ONE LETTER AND ITS IMPLICATIONS

This work attends a letter sent on 1925, by Branimir Truhelka, than director of Geophysical Institution in Zagreb, to the Minister of Education in Belgrade, from which, directly or indirectly, we learn several things: the conditions in science of that time, particularly in Astronomy, on the role and importance of Milutin Milanković in it, but also concerning the Astronomical Observatory, on her help to Geophysical Institution, and on the possible consequences of the non fulfilling of the requirements from this letter: later difficulties for researchers from Belgrade, to use the Archive of Dubrovnik, when he was managed by Branimir Truhelka
